 - a) **094-22. Councilor Marisa Fleming, on behalf of Tom Siart, to install a berm on the backside of 280 Arn How Farm Road to mitigate flooding in his yard from water running down Billings Road.** (REFERRED from City Council on April 5, 2022)
 - b) **095-22. Councilor Marisa Fleming, on behalf of Cindy Cote, to install well constructed asphalt, stone or granite berm at 161 Marshall Road to reduce any further erosion to the front of property due to increased traffic during the summer months as well as winter plowing during the snowy months.** (REFERRED from City Council on April 5, 2022)
